We have 43 groups in our area, most of which meet once or twice a week. Two groups are virtual: one meets seven days a week, and the other meets once a week. Three groups are hybrid and they each meet once a week. One in-person group is ASL interpreted thanks to a grassroots effort by home group members to organize interpreter services. Our H&I subcommittee currently serves ten facilities. We publish a quarterly newsletter to help members across the area connect and stay up to date on birthdays, events, meetings needing support, and service opportunities. Fellowship development 'meeting of the month' event to organize a large group of recovering addicts to attend a meeting and fellowship before or after that meeting each month. The Miracles and Solutions group in our area has hosted a couple of speaker jams with food and fun activities. One of our newer groups had a first anniversary celebration, and had an awesome spring campout! All of these events have been well attended by our fellowship, and almost all of our service positions are currently filled!

Recovering addicts in our area are working hard to get things rolling for TBRCNA 2027. Please spread the word in your areas!!

Our area brainstormed ideas for how our region can save some money to get the regional budget out of the red. We are bringing two proposals in new business later in the agenda: one proposal to switch to all-virtual regional service committee meetings, and a separate proposal to *not* purchase another owl conference camera until our region has managed to stay in the black for one calendar year.

SETANA AREA RCM-1 REPORT

Greetings trusted servants,

SETANA local meetings are receiving a boost from our local convention in the way of newcomers coming to our meetings, especially the noon meetings which are in Beaumont.

There are 3 noon meetings in Beaumont per week.

Altogether, we have 38 meetings a week in our draw area which serves Jefferson County (Beaumont & Nederland), Orange County (Rose City and Orange, TX), and Tyler county (Woodville, TX). We hope to expand to Hardin County in the Silsbee, TX area soon.

H&I efforts are slow with only 2 treatment centers being served in Beaumont, and one more is in discussion. Our Stiles Unit Prison meeting may be in the works this summer. We have struggled to get enough volunteers to sign up for visiting permissions with TDCJ, and now have almost enough people approved to go through with holding meetings inside Stiles. More info will be forthcoming as soon as TDCJ officials approve one more person—we will then move forward.

Our local SETACNA 3 Convention was a success, by all accounts. We made a modest profit, and got our money back. Some convention merchandise was left over, and probably will be donated to various events in the coming year.

The 2028 TBRCNA Convention in Beaumont is still in discussion. We are just recuperating from our own convention and the trauma has not worn off yet. I saw the Facilitator's report mentioned that: "Reminder: The 2028 TBRCNA will be held in Beaumont hosted by

Questions that was asked in this discussion. Was that? Were we donating literature? To for profit treatment centers and we're not. There's actually four regions in Iran. What was said at at the conference was that every three Hours. An addict dies. The first meeting was held. In Dublin. In 1979. There are 83 areas. The 40th Regional Convention is in November. There was a quote. That we were given. That we don't choose to be a service, we get chosen. I just wanted to begin there. To begin to describe some of. Highlights. In the document that will be released. We'll walk through some of the other details of what took place at the conference. I think it's important that we walk through it together so that your questions. Can be answered. And you'll have the document to share with your areas. Now moving forward. That the RCM. Needs to become very different. In that. It will have more responsibilities. Because of the vital importance of their role. To the groups One of the Items that we need to address this morning. NEW BUSINESS

Proposal #1

BVANA:

Section 7.10.4: To remove “The remaining profit after the seed money is deducted will be distributed 50% to the RSC and 50% to NAWS.” To replace with “The remaining profit after the seed money is deducted will be distributed to the RSC. The RSC will also be responsible to ensure that the TBRCNA bank account is replenished prior to the next year’s convention committee being given access to the account, if the previous year’s convention ended with a shortfall.”

Intended to be retroactive with the close of the TBRCNA-26 convention. We are open to a friendly amendment to be in effect after this year’s convention.

Intent: Considering the current economic trend, the TBRCNA event is now the major fundraising event in the Region, surpassing 7th tradition yearly contributions from the Areas in the Region.

Section 7.10.3 5th bullet item: “The RSC authorizes the Treasurer to apply the following recurrent expenses per RSC. *Narcotics Anonymous World Services (NAWS), 20% of funds remaining at the end of each RSC, excluding the prudent reserve.” This clause continues to ensure that the NA funds flow as prescribed in the NA Guide to Local Services in a more practical manner. That does not hamstring RSC with an annual convention separate donation. That was in the past year been divided 3 times, so that we would have the funds to maintain operation as a Region. At the February RSC we pasted a proposal to move the NAWS contribution from right after the event to August. This only kicked the can down the road without addressing the income side of the economic equation. That could help cover our budgetary expenses.

In the past, we have a consistent history of passing along funds, when monies exceeded the prudent to NAWS. This will probably continue funds permitting.

Consensus was reached for this proposal, with the friendly amendment to simply remove the 50%-50% verbiage regarding the donation.

Proposal #4

CTANA

That the Regional Service Committee (RSC) meet virtually starting after the May 2026 RSC.

Any other interim meetings shall be held virtually (extra CAR/CAT meetings due to ever changing WSC cycles, etc...).

Intent: To reduce the cost of holding RSC meetings. TBRNA is not sustaining itself financially, and needs to reduce costs where possible for the time being until the TBRNA budget is stabilized. Hopefully someday soon we can return to hybrid and/or in-person meetings when we can afford it.

Benefit: Reduces cost to rent a facility suitable for hybrid meetings, and reduces the cost of the RSC reimbursing members of the administrative body for travel expenses. Virtual meetings are easier to participate in compared to hybrid meetings - less side talk, easier to hear folks speak, reduces and or eliminates setting up time for hybrid meetings. We can stay connected in person by attending other areas' events and conventions.

Financial Impact: Currently the RSC has 14 admin positions with each having travel expenses allowed per policy to an RSC of \$300.00/each. That's a possible \$4200.00(16,800.00 yearly) for each RSC. Realistically folks don't usually need to be reimbursed for those full amounts allowed in the budget. So as a conservative estimate, TBRNA could reduce annual expenses by ~\$6300.00-\$12600.00. Without the treasury audit results, it's hard to get a more accurate estimate.

Tradition and/or Concepts that apply: Concept 11 states that 'NA funds are to be used to further our primary purpose and must be managed responsibly.' Concept 1 states that 'To fulfill our Fellowship's primary purpose. The NA groups have joined together to create a structure which develops, coordinates, and maintains services on behalf of NA as a whole.'

It was stated by several other members that we have previously had this discussion and this idea has been blocked twice before today. Due to that, the Facilitator decided to not permit this proposal to be presented for consensus. That decision was challenged by the maker and the Facilitator stepped aside, which seated the Co-Facilitator. At that time, Mario V. called for a straw poll of that block. Consensus was reached that the Facilitator's decision should stand and he was returned to the chair. Proposal was, ultimately not presented for consensus.
