

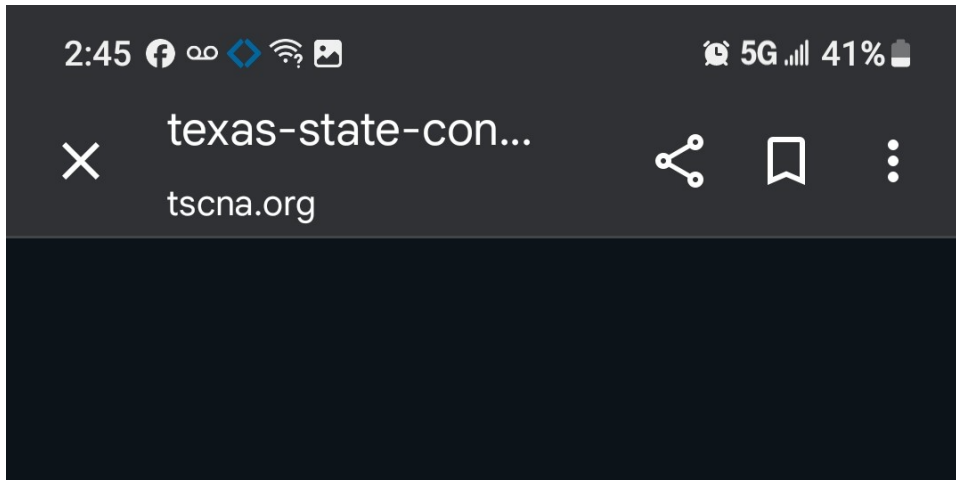

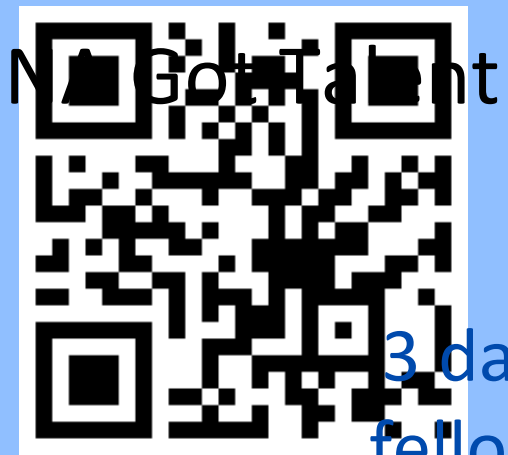

## **OLD BUSINESS**

### **Summer RSC Proposal #1 - From CTANA**

Change regional policy such that only the regional committee member (RCMs) are counted as voting members during consensus-based decision making (CBDM) when proposals are discussed at regional service committee (RSC) meetings for the Texas Bluebonnet Region of Narcotics Anonymous (TBRNA). This includes both new and old business. Trusted servants are welcome to participate in discussing proposals, but RCMs carrying the conscience of their area are the only participants in the final decision-making process under CBDM. We do not propose any changes to TBRNA policy regarding how RCMs will vote. **PASSED-NO OFFICIAL COUNT WAS COMMUNICATED TO RECORDER**

## **NEW BUSINESS**

### **New Proposal #1 - Satch G RCM2, EANA**

Amend TBRNA policy to state that all members of the administrative committee; i.e. facilitator, co-facilitator, treasurer, co-treasurer, recorder, co-recorder, regional delegate, regional delegate-alternate, resign their position as RCM, if applicable, when elected to a position on the administrative committee.

**Intent:** As the policy, under section 3, Proposals (p.7), is worded presently, “Only RCMs will participate in decision-making on business proposals that have been sent back to the areas for consideration.”. This would insulate the CBDM process from influence by the administrative committee on proposals that would be acted upon at the region, that would not be sent back to the areas for consideration/input. **FAILED 6 TO 1**

### **New Proposal #2 - Satch G RCM2, EANA**

“RCMs may serve on any regional sub-committee, except in the position of facilitator.”

**Intent:** As the policy, under section 3, Proposals (p.7), is worded presently, “Only RCMs will participate in decision-making on business proposals that have been sent back to the areas for consideration.”. This would prevent “double-dipping”, a

representative wearing a RCM hat to vote when policy states otherwise. This would make the decision-making process clear without the possibility of challenges being raised by a concern of a perceived or possible “conflict of interest”. FAILED 6 TO 1
